Location: Rocky Mountain House, Lethbridge, Peace River
Position Responsibilities: Supporting the management of ACA's Conservation Sites, your primary responsibilities will include: Inspection, maintenance and repair of streambank fences and fisheries access sites; installation of watering site panels on crown leases and private land; liaison with landowners and representatives from other companies.
Qualifications: Outlined work will require travel throughout much of Alberta, with all work-related expenses provided (i.e., accommodations, meals, vehicles).
